

## SPECIFIC INDICATIONS ESTABLISHED BY THE ACADEMIC COMMITTEE FOR THE DOCTORAL THESES COMPENDIUM IN THE SOCIAL COMMUNICATIONS PROGRAMME

## ARTICLE 1 OF THE THESIS STANDARDS BY COMPENDIUM:

Requirements of the Thesis Modality as a compendium of publications.

Article 1. Regarding the number and type of publications: Prior to the submission of the thesis and with the express authorisation of their supervisor or co-directors, doctoral students who communicate and have published or have been accepted for publication may choose to submit their thesis in the form of a compendium of publications: a) At least three articles in scientific journals listed in the Journal of Citation Reports (or SJR Scimago), two of them in the first half of the list of the thematic unit corresponding to the thesis work.

b) Or five articles in indexed journals included in the MIAR database, as well as appearing in the first quartile of the list corresponding to the journals of the thematic unit related to the thesis work. In the cases referred to in sections a) and b) above, papers in abstract form, in proceedings or in journal supplements will not be accepted as valid contributions for the thesis modality by compendium of publications. Review papers, case reports, opinions, letters, jurisprudential commentaries, introductions, annotations to texts, etc., will not be valid. c) The same applies to a book or three chapters of a book published by a national or international publisher of recognised prestige that appear in Scholary Publishers Indicators (Books in Humanities and Sciences) (SPI), Web of Science (WOS/Scopus), Scopus (Elsevier), Latindex (Catalogue) (Regional Online Information System for Scientific Journals of Latin America, the Caribbean, Spain and Portugal).

## **SPECIFIC INDICATION:**

In the Social Communication Programme, the thesis is eligible for the compendium thesis when the requirements of article 1 points a) or b) are fulfilled. Section (c) shall be amended to read as follows:

The same shall apply if in option a), one of the 3 articles is replaced by a book chapter or in option b), two articles are replaced by two book chapters published by a national or international publisher of recognised prestige appearing in Scholary Publishers Indicators (Books in Humanities and Sciences) (SPI), Web of Science (WOS/Scopus), Scopus (Elsevier), Latindex (Catalogue) (Regional Online Information System for Scientific Journals of Latin America, the Caribbean, Spain and Portugal), and Latindex (Catalogue) (Regional Online Information System for Scientific Journals of Latin America, the Caribbean, Spain and Portugal).
